1. Alcohol may be served at UUCS events if all applicable policies are followed.
2. Any time that alcohol is present all applicable state and federal laws will be followed.
 - Event organizers are responsible for the monitoring and enforcement of applicable state and federal laws.
 - At no time is anyone allowed to become noticeably intoxicated.
3. Non-alcoholic alternatives must be made available, and served separately, at all events where alcohol is present.
4. Alcohol will not be stored in places readily available to minors.
5. In order to promote a comfortable and safe environment for all of our members and visitors consistent with our UU values, if it is known that an event will have alcohol then all advertisements for the event will indicate that alcohol will be present and a non-alcoholic alternative will be available.
6. Alcohol may not be served to minors
 - The only exception to this is if alcohol is being served as part of a religious observance where the parent or legal guardian has given consent and the parent or guardian is the person to serve alcohol to the minor.
7. All rental contracts must include/will include an alcohol agreement.
