



## 1. How important is social justice to you?




## 2. How important is social justice as a Unitarian Universalist value?



## 3. Do you donate money to social justice causes?




4. If so, list no more than 3 social justice causes you donate to in order of importance to you.



### 6. Do you participate in groups or organizations that promote social justice?




